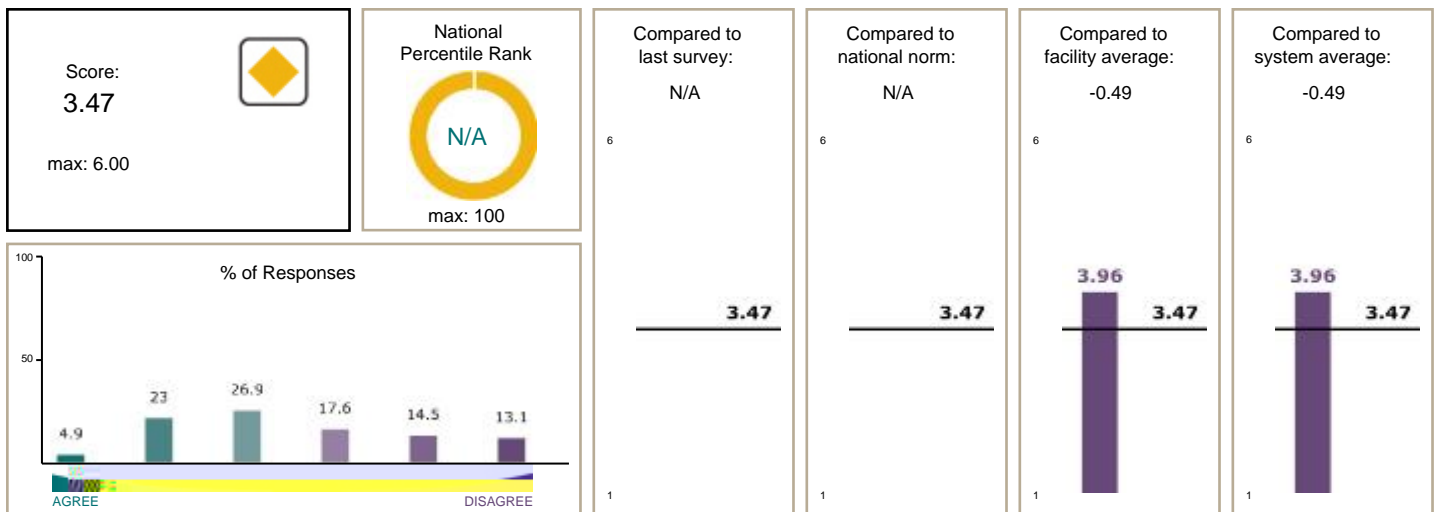

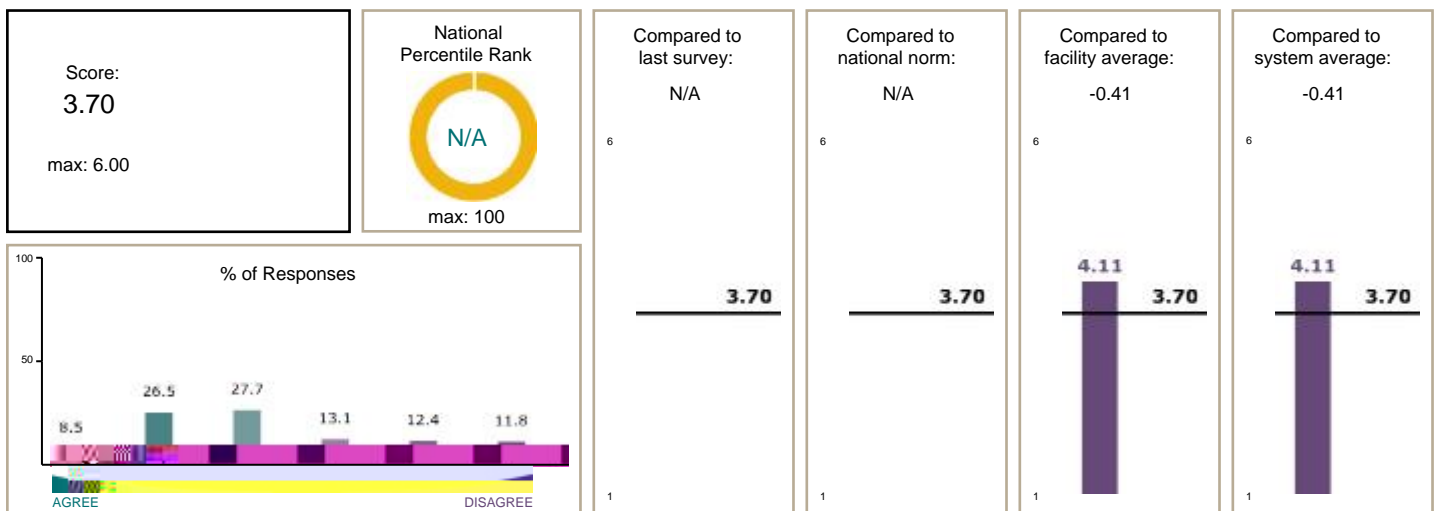

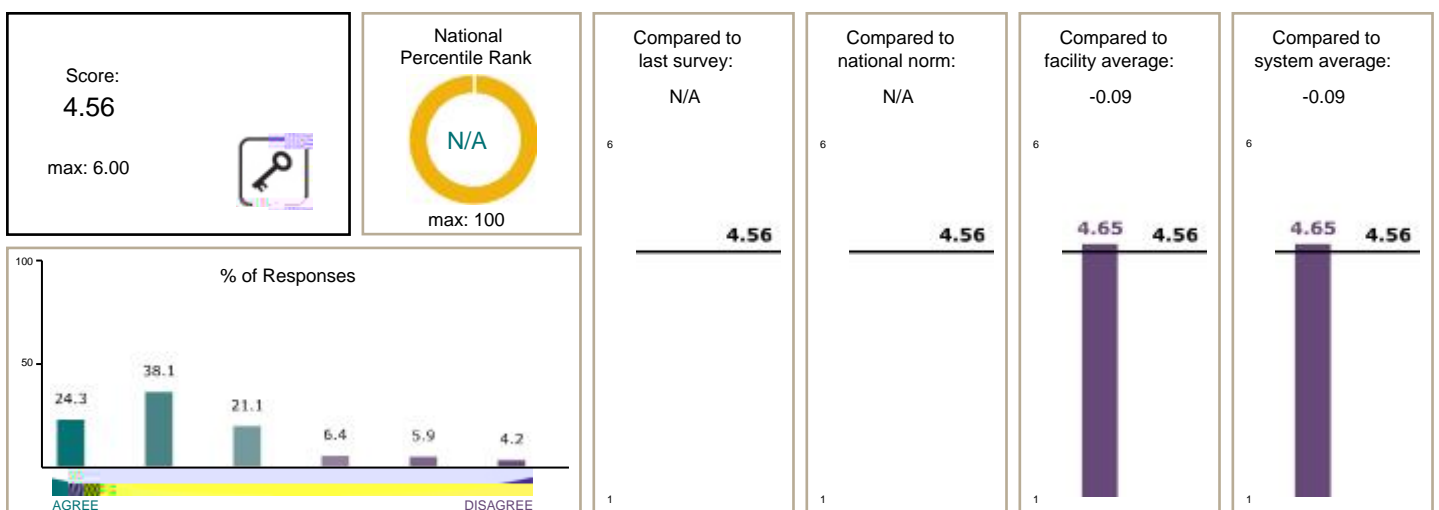

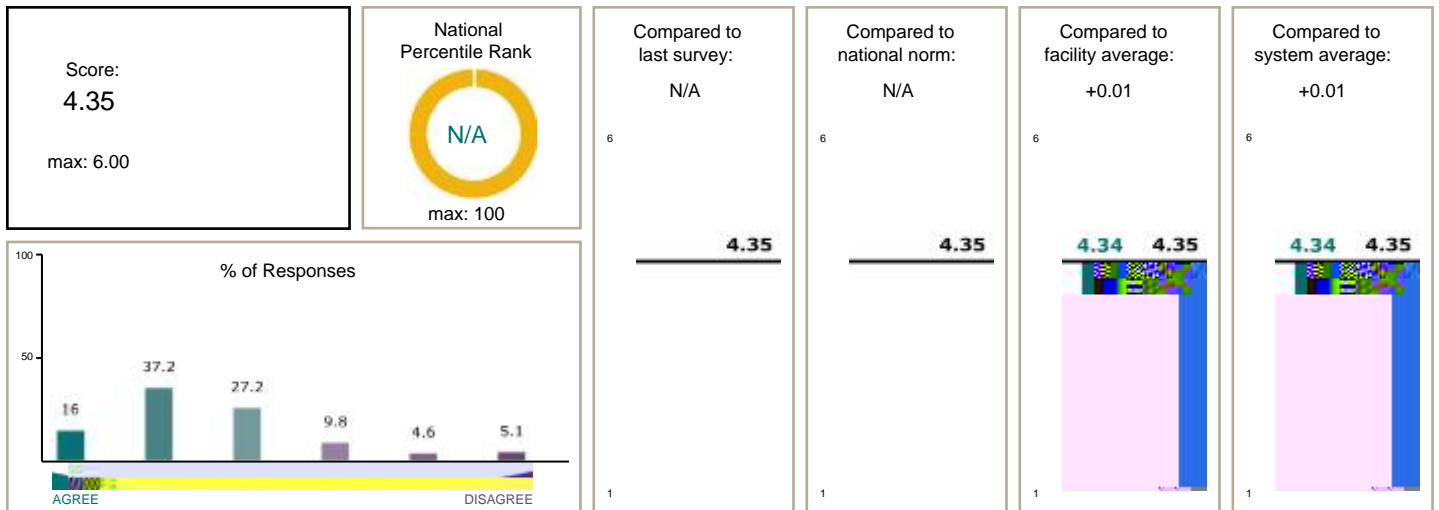

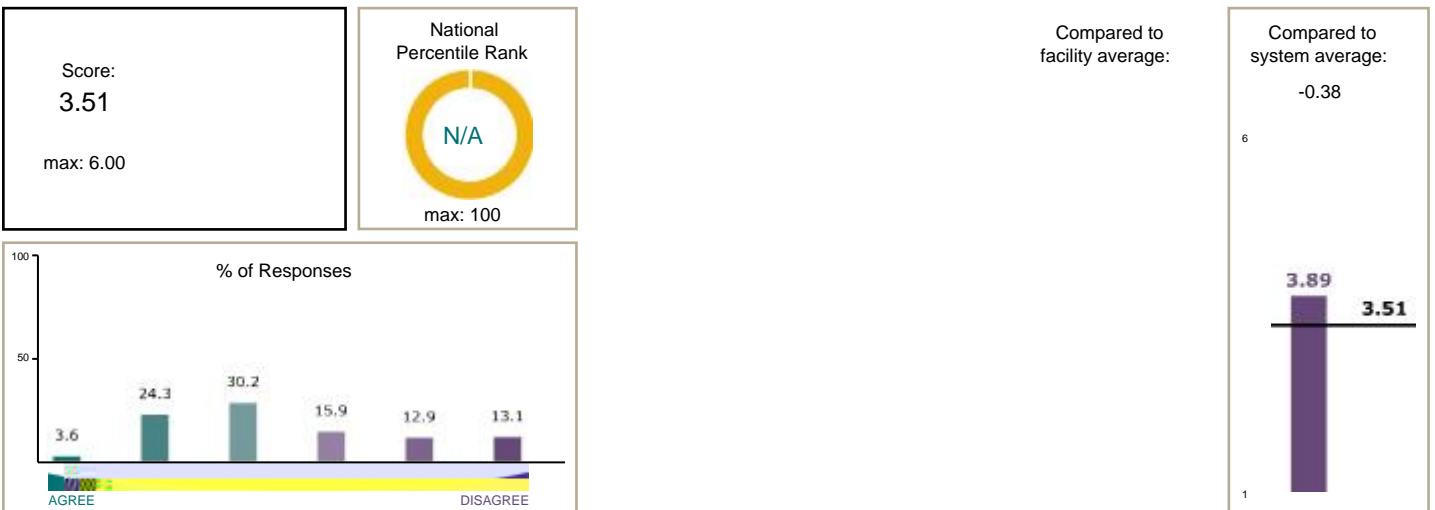

Statement: The exec. leadership at CU Boulder does a good job of prioritizing initiatives.

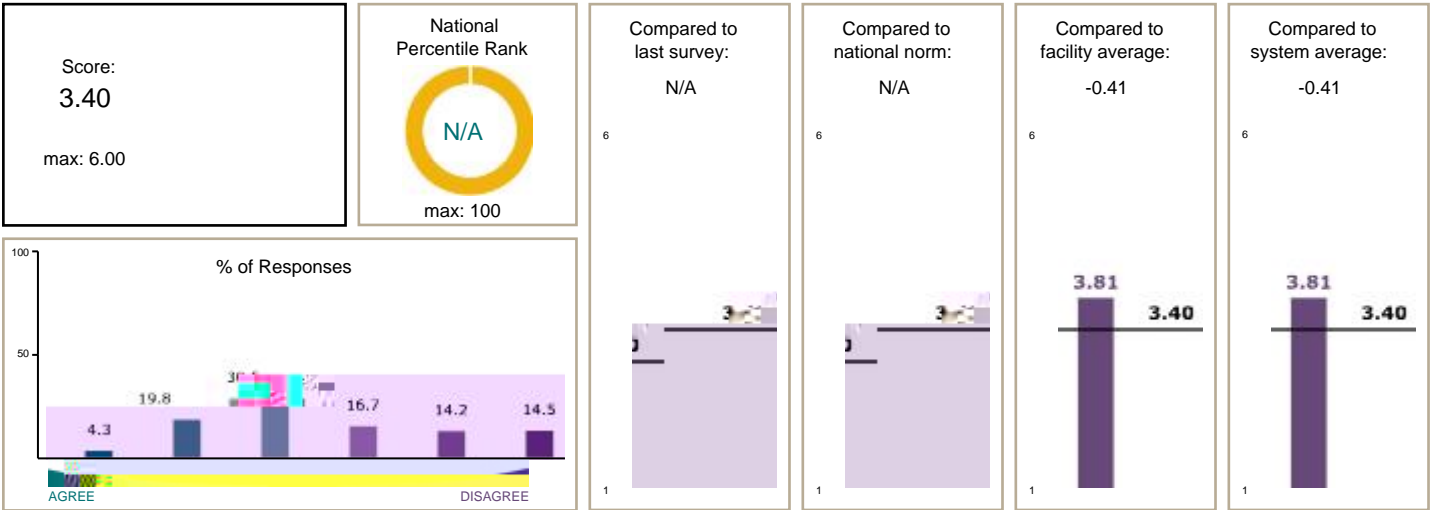

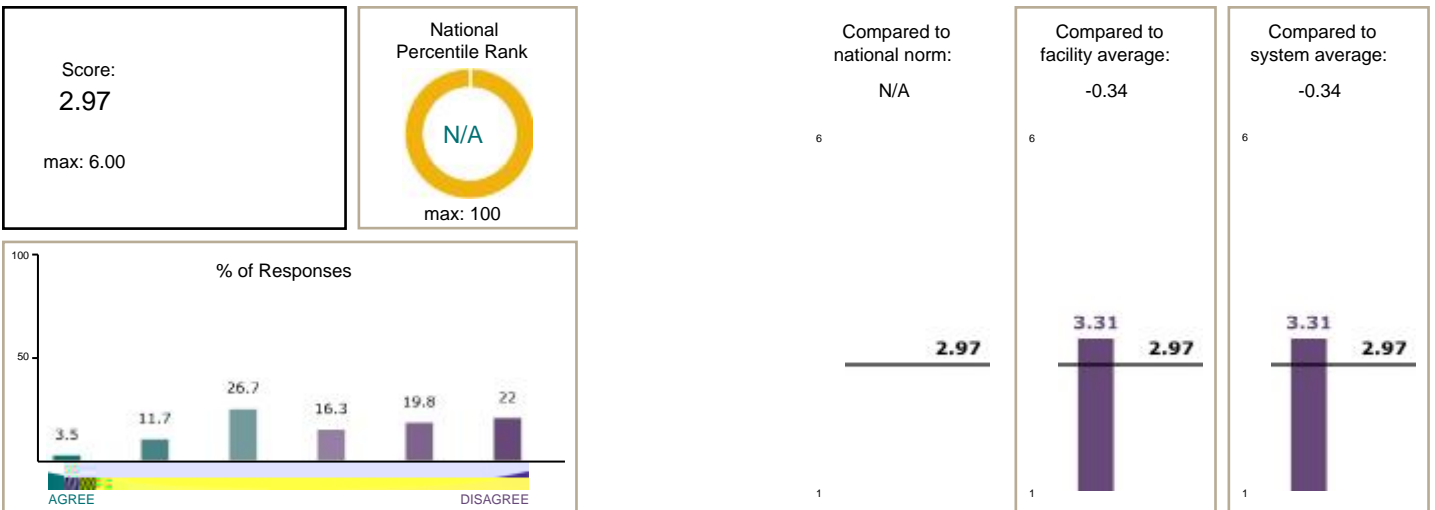
Statement: The leadership by the executive leadership enhances CU Boulder's competitiveness.

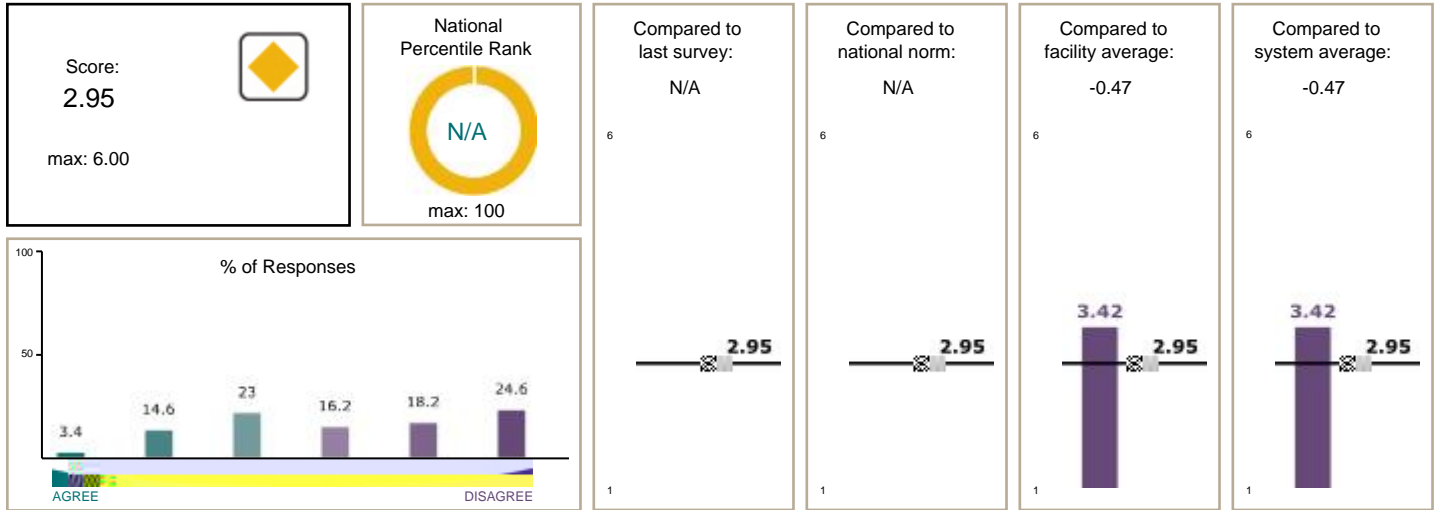

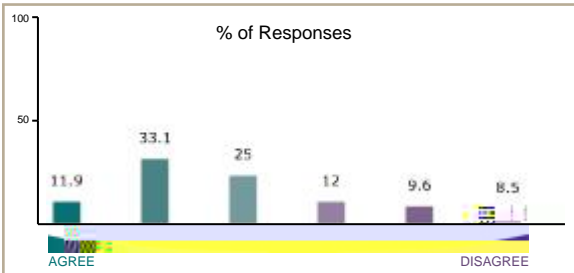

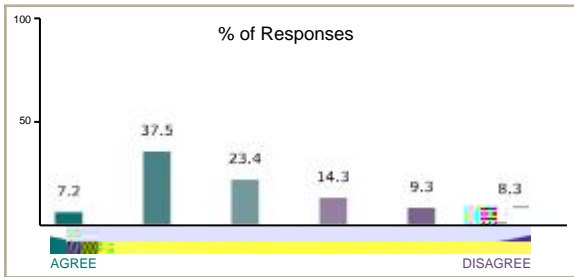
